Last Happy Laps of the year!

When the chequered flag comes out that's it for 2021. Book early so you don't miss out. We only accept 40 cars at Lakeside.



The Qld Raceways approved COVID SAFE plan applies to all operations at *Lakeside*.

SOCIAL DISTANCING OF A MINIMUM OF 1.5 METRES BETWEEN PEOPLE STILL APPLIES, NO HAND SHAKING, NO HUGGING. WHERE SOCIAL DISTANCING IS NOT POSSIBLE MASKS SHOULD BE WORN.

THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OF ALL PEOPLE PRESENT IS PARAMOUNT!

There will be breakfast, albeit not in the accustomed 'sit down format'. It will instead be served from the Café or food van located in pit area. You will get egg & bacon burgers, hash browns and sausages. You will have to eat outdoors.

A brief summary of what you need to do to participate:

- 1) You need to email your booking and forward your completed electronic self-scrutineering form (R5) to one of the people listed at the bottom of this flyer.
- 2) **You don't need to be a club member to participate. Bookings from non RCCQ members are welcome.**
- 3) We will confirm your booking and email you an unique booking number.
- 4) You must make to your payment to the RCCQ **electronically) (EFT)** by depositing funds into the RCCQ's account, or by going to a Bank of Qld branch and depositing the money there.
Your payment must arrive in the Club's account not later than Saturday 25 September.
- 5) **Bank details:**

Due to Covid-19 we will not handle cash or paperwork on the day

You should arrive at **Lakeside** by 7.00am on Sunday 26 September 2021.

Should you develop any **Covid-19 symptoms** between the time of making your booking and the day of the event **you MUST NOT attend Happy Laps.**

You should contact your GP or nearest hospital for advice.

If you do suffer from Covid related illness, please let us know. We'll refund your money or arrange a credit for a future event, whichever you prefer.

Please read the entire document so you don't miss any important information.

- **You can come to Happy Laps in any safe road registered car,**
- **It doesn't have to be a Renault,**
- **It doesn't have to be sporty.**
- **It doesn't have to be new.**
- **It is all about having a bit of fun in these unprecedented and trying times.**

Not a Renault!



At Happy Laps:

*You get to drive on a race track for about half an hour

*You don't need a special racing licence and you can use your normal roadworthy car. You don't need a sporty car.

*It is great fun. There's no easier or cheaper way to drive on the track!

*It is exciting, but not at all scary! Why not give it a go?

However, there are some rules:

- You **must** book a place. You can't just turn up!
- Only roadworthy road registered cars may participate.
- Cars must **NOT** have an after-market roll cage/bar fitted.
- You must **NOT** wear a helmet.
- You must **NOT** stop anywhere on the circuit.
- The Happy Laps session will be ended for **EVERYBODY** in the event of car to car contact, spins, excursions off the track, tyre smoking or any other evidence of 'over-driving'.
- Speed is nominally limited to about 120km/h.
- You **MUST** attend the Driver's Briefing, **adhere to social distancing** and obey the rules.
- Your entry fee buys a **coloured wrist band**, which gets you a free breakfast and allows you to go on the track, either as a driver or a passenger. Member's *children under thirteen are free*.
- Everybody must be 'drug free and alcohol free'. You may be required to undergo breath or other drug testing.
- Everybody must wear a seatbelt to go on the track.
'Happy Laps' is **NOT** a race or a **flat-out** sprint session!
- Drive at a speed where you feel comfortable and safe.



Please don't create a situation like this. Look in your mirrors and move out of the way. If other cars are faster through the curvy sections, don't "drag race" them on the straight, let them pass. It is not just good manners, it is the RULE.

What you need to do now:

Email a Sporting Sub-Committee member with a completed 'Self-Scrutineering Form R5 for each car and deposit the entry fee into our Bank Account (Details are listed on Page 5 of this document)
(Electronic version of SS form is attached to our promotional email)

You will be emailed an unique 'Happy Laps Booking Number'.

The 'early bird' cost per adult for a **coloured wrist band** is:

*After Wed. 22 September, a late booking surcharge of \$5 may apply. If you cancel without good reason, you may still be required to pay.

What you need to do on the day:-

- Bring your nominated registered, roadworthy car, your current road driver's licence and your Happy Laps Booking Number.
- **Be at Lakeside no later than 7.00am.** At the gate, say that you are part of the Renault Happy Laps group. Then follow the road around the outside of the circuit in an anti-clockwise direction until about halfway around, then turn left into the tunnel under the circuit. Then turn right and park with the group of Renaults in front of the café building.
- 7.00am - 7.15am approx. – Booking, payment and Self Scrutineering Form (R5) check. **The completed form must be returned to us attached to your booking email.** Your entry fee will purchase a **coloured wrist band, which is required to get breakfast &/or go on the track, even as a passenger.**
- Breakfast will then be distributed from the cafe followed by the compulsory Driver's Briefing.
- You **must** attend the compulsory drivers briefing.
- At about 7.45am we'll have about 30 minutes on the track.

- You can then go straight home or stay to watch whatever is on. We suggest that you wear non-synthetic long sleeved and legged clothing, plus shoes with closed toes.

Lakeside Park is about 30km north of Brisbane at the end of Lakeside Rd, off Narangba Rd, Dakabin - refer UBD Map 88, ref G5.

NOTE - Some important points to check are:

- Brakes Appropriate pedal pressure, fluid level, leaks, function etc, (Renew brake fluid if possible)
- Steering No undue play
- Suspension No undue wear
- Wheels Tightly bolted to hub, no significant damage or deterioration
- Tyres Street legal tread depth, remember to adjust pressures
- Fluids No undue fluid leaks
- Battery Firmly mounted to the body
- Loose items No loose items in the interior, boot, or engine bay
- Seat belts Freedom from fraying and damage, fixings etc
- General: Examine all relevant items to ensure 'track-worthiness'.
